LAND USE MASTER PLAN

BERK Consultant Lisa Grueter presented the Land Use Master Plan Power Point presentation. Consultant opened the opportunity for questions from the commissioners, & collected all of their final questions & comments for the upcoming finalization of the plan. Sam provided some additional insight, as well as deadlines regarding this plan.

OPEN PUBLIC HEARING

Commissioner Idsinga makes motion to approve the preferred alternative with a modification to change the zoning on the Cook property from R3 to R5 and direct staff and the consultants to

write in policies into the draft land use master plan that look at exploring growth opportunities south of 502 and some of the non-designated agricultural land just west of the city's urban growth boundary. Commissioner Kysar seconded the motion. A vote followed, all in favor, motion passed unanimously.

Emily commented there are no new reports. Reported there have been inquiries regarding the Parks Plan.


ADJOURNMENT
