APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Commissioner Idsinga made a motion to approve the September 29th minutes, and Commissioner Calderon seconded. Planning Commission approved the minutes unanimously.

TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM PLAN UPDATE

Public Works Director Mark Herceg presented the transportation system update plan accompanied by consultant Matthew Hughart. Mark responded to questions offered by the commission, which included re-prioritizing items on the plan, discussing a parking plan downtown near Grace Ave, & which road improvement projects were being considered.

WATER SYSTEM PLAN UPDATE

Mark Herceg also presented the Water System Plan Update, which discussed city water conservation, facilities upgrades, & residential/non-residential water usage history while replying to questions presented by the commission.

FIRE CAPITAL FACILITIES PLAN UPDATE

Fire Marshal/Building Official Chris Drone presented the Fire Capital Facilities Plan to the commission, which included city growth in regards to residential & non-residential aspects as well as the history & future of increasing fire impact fees, & what those fees are attributed to.

REPORTS & INFORMATION

Emily Lutz updated the commission on the Parks Recreation & Open Spaces Plan, & the methods of the distribution of the survey.


ADJOURNMENT
