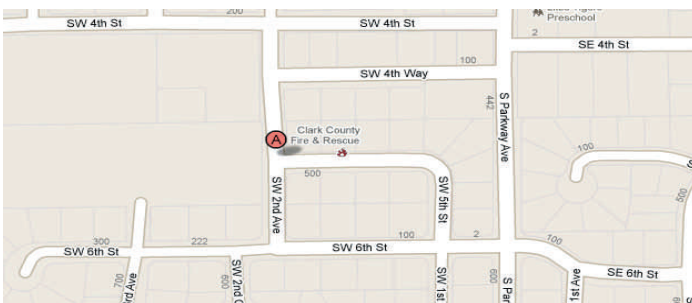


Kiwanis Park is the largest Community Park in the City of Battle Ground. Through a generous donation from the Kiwanis Club the property was deeded to the City in 1980 to establish a park. After extensive park improvements in 2006 this 8+ acre park has become a Mecca for both active and passive recreation users. It features a large playground with a climbing rock, water spray feature and basketball court. A 1/4 mile paved path loops around a large open grass area which is popular with both exercise walkers and those taking a leisurely stroll.
