

ORDINANCE NO. 241

AN ORDINANCE of the Town of Battle Ground establishing the Town of Battle Ground as a non-charter code city under RCW Title 35A.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Battle Ground⁵⁸ duly passed Resolution No. 159 at its regular meeting on June 3, 1975, declaring its intention to change the classification of said Town from that of the Town of the fourth class to that of a non-charter code city; and

WHEREAS, said resolution was duly published in the manner and form required by law and more than ninety (90) days have elapsed since the date of the first publication thereof; and

WHEREAS, no referendum petition has been filed with respect to such resolution,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BATTLE GROUND AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Town of Battle Ground, Washington, hereby adopts the classification of non-charter code city operating under the Mayor-Council Plan of Government as set forth in Chapter 35A.12 of the Revised Code of Washington, endowed with all the applicable rights, powers, privileges, duties and obligations of a non-charter code city as set forth in Title 35A of said Revised Code of Washington as the same now exists, including, but not by way of limitation, those set forth in Title 35A.11 of said Title, and further including all supplements, amendments and other modifications of said Title herein after at anytime enacted.

Section 2. The Town Clerk is hereby directed to forward to the Secretary of the State of Washington, a certified copy of this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after five (5) days from the date of its passage and publication.


